

1.1 Certification Logo

The logo illustrated below can be used for a certified ICT product after achieving a successful certification.



The holder of a certificate may affix a mark and label to a certified ICT product. Mark and label demonstrate that the ICT product has been certified in accordance with the EUCC (*Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/482*). Mark and label shall be affixed on the product in accordance with article 11 and Annex VI of the EUCC.

1.2 Swedac Accreditation Symbol

Certificates and certification reports issued by atsec CB within its accreditation scope will carry the Swedish Board for Accreditation and Conformity Assessment, Swedac, accreditation symbol.

The conditions for use of the Swedac accreditation symbol are stated in STAFS 2020:1 (*Swedish Board for Accreditation and Conformity Assessment (Swedac) Regulations and General Guidelines on Accreditation*).



The accreditation symbol may only be used together with the name, symbol or logo of the accredited body. The accreditation body's logo shall therefore not be used by the holder of a certificate.

1.3 CCRA Certification Mark

A product whose certificate is recognised according to the Common Criteria Recognition Arrangement (CCRA) may carry the CCRA Certification Mark, under the conditions given in the CCRA arrangement (*Arrangement on the Recognition of Common Criteria Certificates in the Field of Information Technology Security*).

This mark confirms that a Common Criteria evaluation was conducted and certified in conformance with the requirements of the CCRA. Upon receipt of a Common Criteria certificate under mutual recognition, certificate holders may use the mark in conjunction with advertising, marketing, and sale of the product for which the certificate is issued. These conditions are further detailed in Annex E of the CCRA arrangement.



1.4 atsec Logo

The name "atsec" and the logo below used by the certification body of atsec AB are trademarks.

A certificate issued by atsec CB can be used by the holder of a certificate in the documentation or marketing material of the certified product. When a certificate holder wants to refer to atsec's logo, the method is to use the entire certificate.

It is not permitted to use the atsec logo as a stand-alone logo on the product to indicate that it is certified.

All certificates and licenses issued by atsec CB will carry the atsec logo and the name of the certification body. At any time, the conditions for the use of the atsec logo can be changed by atsec and the changes are subject to atsec's quality policy. atsec may not be held liable for any damage or costs to other parties resulting from this action.

1.5 Licensed ITSEFs

A license issued to an associated ITSEF (*IT Security Evaluation Facility*) may carry the atsec CB logo.

A license issued by the atsec CB may be used by the ITSEF for marketing its services available within the EUCC.

The atsec CB logo should only be used for marketing ITSEF activities within the EUCC Scheme by reproducing the entire license in an accurate and readable form.

The context and presentation shall make it obvious that the license is only related to the ITSEF activities within their defined scope of the EUCC.

An ITSEF licensed by atsec CB may use the license mark according to the recommendations in this document as long as the ITSEF is still licensed as an associated ITSEF.

The ITSEF shall not use a withdrawn license for marketing purposes.

The marketing of the license shall not be used in any circumstance or context that may be perceived as offensive. This includes slander of individuals or other entities.

1.6 Misuse of Marks and Labels

If a certificate or license is withdrawn, all use of the certificates, certification mark and label or licenses as described in this document shall stop immediately. atsec CB may not be held liable for any damage or cost sustained by other parties as a result of the withdrawal.

atsec CB will take legal actions necessary to prevent the use of the atsec CB certificates or licenses in conflict with the conditions described in this document, the EUCC, or the CCRA arrangement.
